## **Times Square to Close the Curtain on 2025, Usher in the New Year at the 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Good Riddance Day**

New Yorkers and visitors will bid one final goodbye to any unpleasant, frustrating, and forgettable memories from 2025 at the 19<sup>th</sup> annual Good Riddance Day **on Sunday, December 28, at 12:00 p.m., on the Broadway Plaza between 45<sup>th</sup> and 46<sup>th</sup> Streets**. This year's Good Riddance Day event offers participants the opportunity to close the curtain on any unhappy memories from 2025 and usher in the new year, allowing all to enter 2026 feeling lighter and with a clean slate.

Jonathan Bennett, host of the Times Square New Year's Eve celebration, will lead the event from an elevated stage where participants will join him in tossing out bad, unpleasant memories. Participants will write their bad memories on oversized tickets that they will tear (as a theater usher would at a show), toss the larger portion into a trash can, keep the smaller portion as a memento, and take a bow.
