### **BEHIND-THE-SCENES, PRE-EVENT COVERAGE OF TIMES SQUARE 2026**

Pre-New Year's Eve footage featuring the arrival and installation of the "2026" numerals atop of One Times Square, testing of the New Year's Eve Ball, Good Riddance Day, Confetti Test, the Wishing Wall and other preparations.

Pre-event coverage will be available via download, featuring 16 x 9 HD broadcast quality video, B-Roll footage (encoded as H.264), broadcast and web quality pre-packaged EPKs, photos and press releases.

Video content will be uploaded mid-afternoon or evening (EST) on the following dates:

December 1 (Wishing Wall), December 18 (Numeral Arrival), December 26 (Numeral Installation atop One Times Square), December 27 (Crystal Installation), December 28 (Good Riddance Day), December 29 (Confetti Test) and December 30 (Ball Test and Balloon Preparation).

### **FEED #1: BROADCAST LIVE NEW YEAR'S EVE COVERAGE OF TIMES SQUARE 2026**

Live coverage of the Times Square New Year's Eve festivities with exclusive panoramic views from proprietary camera locations with the ambient and natural sounds. Highlights include the lighting and raising of the New Year's Eve Ball at 6 p.m. EST, hourly countdowns, live musical performances by B.o.B ("Airplanes," "Nothin' On You" and new song "Incwadi"), Tones and I ("Gone Gone Gone," "Fly Away," "Dance Monkey" and John Lennon's "Imagine" just before midnight), a performance by New York dance group AGNEW, and the Mayor of New York City pushing the crystal button that signals the Ball Drop at midnight.

Special programming presented by America250 will include a performance of the National Anthem by Jenn O'Hagan and a special kick-off of America's 250<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Year with patriotic nonpartisan imagery leading into Ray Charles' inspirational singing of "America The Beautiful" accompanied by the first ever post-midnight second tidal wave of 2,000 pounds of red, white, and blue confetti and the U.S. flag revealed completely taking over the One Times Square building top to bottom with the Numerals 2026 lit up in red, white, and blue and America250 displayed on the Ball atop the building.

This clean, uninterrupted feed will be provided **free of charge** to media organizations around the world on a non-exclusive basis solely for their use in creating television and streaming programming relating to the event.
